the Italian Sea Group, which will build the yachts, the 16.5-metre 55 is the first of a new line of elegant runabouts that go up to 100ft. Full details of the all-composite boat have yet to emerge,

There is a table on deck for eight and a stowable awning for the sunpads, while the area below decks can be customised for overnighting (for up to five). She'll top out at 35 knots.
